The LeadingAge Iowa Leadership Academy is a self-reflective journey, preparing new and seasoned leaders to better understand their leadership strengths and take their leadership to another level. Participant Criteria

- Class members (referred to as "fellows") must be members of LeadingAge Iowa and complete a one-page application form to be considered for acceptance.
- The selection committee will consist of Julie Thorson, Shannon Strickler and LAILA coaches.
- There will be a minimum class size of 14 fellows and a maximum class size of 21 fellows.
- All fellows will complete a 360-degree leadership evaluation.

Application Process

Applications are due on **January 17, 2024**. Tuition is \$2,625 per participant. No cancellations, refunds, or partial refunds will be processed after the application deadline. Substitutions are welcome only until the application deadline. Sponsors agree to provide tuition in full and cover any other travel, meals not outlined in the "what's included" portion of the brochure, and lodging costs associated with the program for all four summit sessions. It is necessary to make a firm commitment to allow the fellow to attend all four summits and to allow them to participate in conference calls with his/her mentor and/or faculty. <u>Click here</u> to apply.

Continuing Education Information



- Iowa Board of Nursing Provider #67 LeadingAge Iowa has been approved as a provider of continuing education for nurses by the Iowa Board of Nursing, provider No. 67. Up to 11 contact hours for each summit will be available for participants who attend each summit in its entirety. Partial credit for individual sessions will not be granted. To receive contact hours or a certificate of attendance, you must attend the entire summit. Retain your certificate for four years.
- Nursing Home Administrators The content in this program is intended to meet the criteria established by the Iowa Board of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators. Up to 11 contact hours for each summit will be available for participants who attend each summit in its entirety. Partial credit for individual sessions will not be granted. You must attend the entire summit to receive contact hours or a certificate of attendance. Retain your certificate for four years.
- **Certified Dietary Managers** LeadingAge Iowa will seek continuing education approval for each summit for certified dietary managers by the Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals. Partial credit for individual sessions will not be granted. To receive contact hours or a certificate of attendance, you must attend the entire summit. If audited, you will be asked to provide your certificate of attendance and program material. Retain certificate for six years. Log in to <u>www.ANFPonline.org</u> to report your CE credit using the Prior Approval Program ID# for each Summit.
- Social Workers The content in this program is intended to meet the criteria established by the Iowa Board of Examiners for Social Workers. Up to 11 contact hours for each summit will be available for participants who attend each summit in its entirety. Partial credit for individual sessions will not be granted. You must attend the entire summit to receive contact hours or a certificate of attendance. Retain your certificate for four years.
- LAI Assisted Living Leadership Recertification Up to 11 contact hours for each summit will be available for participants who attend each summit in its entirety. Partial credit for individual sessions will not be granted. To receive contact hours or a certificate of attendance, you must attend the entire summit. Retain your certificate for two years.
- For other long-term support and service provider professional not listed above: Most licensure boards, credentialing agencies and professional organizations have processes that allow individuals to earn a certain number of CEUs for non-preapproved programs and/or to accommodate self-submission for approval of continuing education hours after the event takes place with proper documentation from the program sponsors. Most also require information objectives, date/time of presentation, agendas, faculty bios and number of hours earned.
