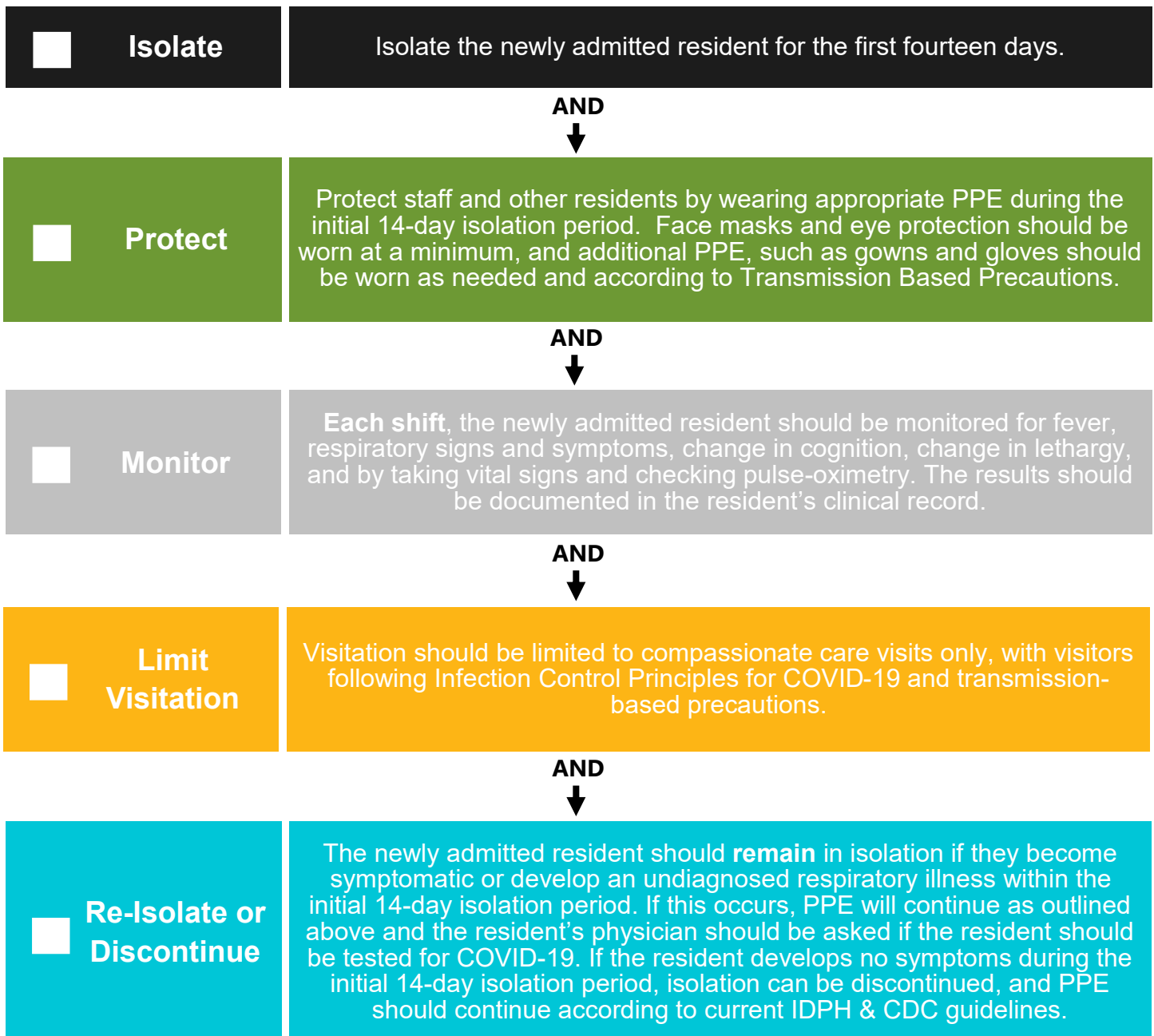


Admission Guidance — Asymptomatic Residents Who Are Not Fully Vaccinated

This guide is to assist in determining admission best practices during the COVID-19 pandemic. Because a new admission who is not fully vaccinated may have been unknowingly exposed to someone with COVID-19, even while in the hospital, the following steps are recommended for the first 14 days of the resident's stay.
