This session will focus on exploring the three domains of the CMS 5-Star Quality Rating System: Health Inspections, Staffing, and Quality Measures. The recent changes in the 5-Star Rating system will be reviewed. You will learn how the health inspection, staffing, quality measure, and overall rating is calculated. Tips on how to analyze your data and develop plans to achieve 5-Star status will be discussed.
