Infection Control Workshop

June 26, 2019

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Infection prevention and control in long term care is a major focus of state and federal agencies. Long term care providers must provide safe, competent, person-centered care, including preventing and managing infections. This interactive workshop will include activities that address the required basic elements of an infection prevention and control program (IPCP), based upon Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regulations. A review of key policies to include hand hygiene and antibiotic stewardship. Discussion about Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement (QAPI) will take place including ways to integrate the infection prevention and control program into QAPI.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

At the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Compare and contrast the strengths and opportunities in the participant long term care IPCP.
- Select appropriate infection prevention and control resources and tools.
- Formulate a plan to develop and maintain an effective IPCP utilizing evidence-based strategies and resources.
- Explore the role of the Infection Preventionist and its role in addressing the antibiotic stewardship committee.
- Discuss strategies to effectively integrate the IPCP into QAPI.

Designated infection preventionist, nursing home administrator, DON, ADON, and other nurse leaders.

FACULTY

Deb Patterson Burdsall PhD, RN-BC, CIC, FAPIC

Deb Burdsall has worked in long term care since 1974. She started as a nurse's aide and worked in a variety of roles in long term care, including infection preventionist, staff nurse, interim director of health care services, MDS/care plan coordinator, wound nurse, quality assurance coordinator, and clinical inservice coordinator. Dr. Burdsall is board certified in infection prevention and control (CIC), and ANCC certified in gerontological nursing. Dr. Burdsall has her PhD in nursing from The University of Iowa College of Nursing with a cognate in public health. Her doctoral dissertation examined how health care personnel use gloves when caring for patients, testing the reliability of a new glove use surveillance tool. Dr. Burdsall works to find evidence-based, cost effective infection prevention strategies for long term care.
